What are the "Accident Avoidance Workshops"?

We're the *other* half of driver training ... the part you're never told about. This is a more practical, intense, beneficial and fun program than "driver's ed", or simple programs in car control, and the only program on the East Coast that meets the National Defensive Driving Institute's Level 8 criteria. Sometimes serious but always humorous, this 8-hour, hands-on, one-of-a-kind, parent-participation program is done in your own car, and focuses on EMERGENCY DRIVING CONDITIONS. We show your student what kinds of emergencies can happen, ... let them experience first-hand how fast they happen, ... and train them how to react and what to do when they do happen!

As a result, when they are faced with that inevitable emergency, they have practiced how to handle it. This program helps both under-confident and over-confident drivers, ... and leaves parents much more comfortable with their student's abilities.

Who can enroll?: We have 32 spaces available each weekend, or 8 in each driving session. Any permitted/licensed driver, and basic vehicle control may attend. Registration is open for any and everyone, so feel free to pass this invitation around!

At least one parent is required to attend the entire program with their students.

How much does it cost?: The regular price is \$319 per parent/student team. But thanks to Bristol Motor Speedway's support, you receive the discounted price of **\$225** for student and parent or **\$265** for student and both parents, in which case, all 3 would be eligible for Defensive Driving Certificates, which can drastically lower your insurance rates if you haven't done so in the past 3 years.

Registration tip: *Don't hesitate* to ask to be excused from an extracurricular school activity, sport or event to attend the Workshops. Teachers and coaches alike understand you are ultimately responsible for your kids' lives and decisions until they're 18. They know teens aren't dying in extracurricular activities, they're dying in car crashes ... so they will support/applaud your priorities.

How long is the program?: *It's a new, longer program now with more exercises! An 8 hour program delivered in 2 parts:*

- 1- Choose a weekend that's convenient for you.
- 2- Choose a 5 hour driving sessions on that weekend:
Morning OR afternoon on either Saturday OR Sunday ... whatever doesn't mess up your schedule.
